- 6) Committee reports:
 - <u>Spirit Wear</u>: Amy Hilston- Sale went great. PayPal took a fee from every person. Less than anticipated was raised.
 - <u>Student Directory</u>: Chris Flaherty/Colleen Turcsanyi Dr. Tocci to send out an email blast to collect data. There are 3 options including a 2 step verification for sign in to A to Z, then PTO verifies, then parent goes back in to finish entering data. OR A to Z will load the data OR export data from Infinite Campus. Dr. Tocci and Chris to meet on Thursday to discuss. A to Z is a web based platform with an app for accessibility.
