	218.3. DISORDERS OR PROTESTS
1. Purpose	The Board reaffirms its policy that principals are always available to receive the requests of students in a peaceful, orderly, and reasonable manner, and are free to exercise administrative judgment in a specific instance.
2. Guidelines	<p>To minimize the disruption of the educational process, to assure the safety of students and faculty, and to protect public property, the administration is authorized to implement the following procedures in the event of a student protest:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. In the event of a student strike or disorder, the building principal shall notify the Superintendent and take firm measures.2. The building principal or a designee shall confront the students causing the disturbance. The principal shall make him/herself available to meet immediately with the representatives of the students causing the disturbance and shall inform the other students that they expect them to return to their regular classroom routine.3. If the students fail to abide by such directions, the principal is authorized to take appropriate disciplinary measures, which may include suspension. <p>Should a confrontation of any kind develop, the building principal will submit to the Superintendent, in writing, a complete report of the incident.</p>
