107.1. DROPPING/ADDING COURSES

1. Purpose

The Board provides for the educational needs, abilities and interests of all students by establishing a wide range of course offerings.

2. Guidelines

The district will publish annually during the second semester of the school year a program of studies that advises students and parents of the courses, as well as the requirements and prerequisites for courses, that will be available to students for the next school year.

The district will also distribute course selection sheets that students and parents will use to make informed decisions about students' class schedules. Students are expected to select courses carefully and remain enrolled in those courses for the duration of the school year or semester, as appropriate. Parents and students will be informed of the proper procedures relative to course selection and enrollment, as well as the importance of choosing courses relative to the educational and/or career goals of the students. While deletions and additions to class schedules are not recommended, the individual needs, abilities and interests of students will be fully considered when changes are deemed to be in the best interest of the student.

Guidelines for schedule changes shall be disseminated in student and faculty handbooks.
