



PHASED REOPENING UPDATE

Proposal to Move from Secondary Enhanced Hybrid to Five Day In-Person Instruction

Due to a significant increase in Allegheny County's transmission levels, the District adopted the following plan for additional in-person instruction days. The District will go forward with the planned asynchronous remote learning day scheduled for April 9 to prepare for a possible five-day in-person return on April 12. Please see the following guidance for specific timelines of the transition to additional in-person instruction days:

- If the case count reaches <100 by April 9, 5-day in-person instruction will begin on April 12. (CDC Substantial = PDE Moderate)
- If case count < 100 by April 16, 5-day in-person may begin on April 19, using CDC Substantial vs. High as our guide.
- During the April 12 board meeting, we will review current data and any additional PDE, ACHD, or CDC guidance to inform reopening planning.

Additionally, the enhanced hybrid plan schedule approved for the first two weeks of April is included below.
