PSSA Testing – Attention Parents/Guardians of Students in Grades 3, 4 and 5! The 2021 Pennsylvania System of School Assessments (PSSA) for students in Grades 3, 4 and 5 will be administered following the schedule below. We begin testing each morning at approximately 8:30 am. Tests are considered untimed but will take approximately 40-80 minutes depending on the grade and test. Please be sure that students have a good night's rest and a healthy breakfast. Arrival on time for school is critical, the administration of these assessments is sequential, and classroom interruption cannot occur. Please avoid scheduling any doctor appointments, vacations, etc. during these testing dates. If it is absolutely necessary to schedule an appointment, please make them for the afternoon. If you have additional questions about PSSA testing, please read the attached "Frequently Asked Questions, Information for Parents or Guardians" in our flyer section. We appreciate your efforts to have your child in attendance on all testing dates.

- Benchmark and Accelerated Math Testing: At the end of every academic year, the elementary schools initiate the process of making roster and instructional decisions regarding placement of students in programs including math and/or reading support and Accelerated Math for the 2021-2022 school year. In an attempt to make effective instructional decisions, including enrichment, math acceleration, and remediation, we will be conducting a variety of assessments and data review during the month of May. Accelerated math testing and benchmark testing for reading and math will be administered. Students who have demonstrated a need beyond enrichment will be considered for testing for math acceleration. We will review all data so that we can determine the best instructional program for every student. Based on our data, if your child's instructional program indicates a change for the upcoming school year, you will be contacted to discuss our recommendations.

Please note the accelerated math schedule is as follows:

April 26 – Current Grade K (Grade 1 assessment)

April 27 – Current Grades 1 and 3 Students (Grade 2 and 4 assessments)

April 28 – Current Grade 2 Students (Grade 3 assessment)

April 29 – Current Grades 4 and 5 (Grade 5 and 6 assessments)

April 30 – All Central HOA grades
