
Dear Class of 2020 and Family Members:

Allegheny County is moving to the green phase on June 5th. Under the green phase guidelines, we are allowed to hold an event that includes up to 250 people. Therefore, we are able to allow more families to gather in celebration at the same time. Please review the changes to the ceremony below.

- **Our ceremony will be held on Friday, June 5th** with a rain date of June 6th.
- Graduates may bring **all immediate family members** to the event, this includes siblings, parents, and guardians. For example, under the old system families of six had to decide which child was not attending the ceremony. Under the new system, all children can come.
- Please limit your family to one car.
- Everyone must wear a mask and practice social distancing.
- We are now graduating in three groups, which allows more students to celebrate together. Please use the time you already received to know which group you are in for the June 5th ceremony. **Please do not arrive more than 30 minutes before your new time.**



- **Families will now self-park using the parking lots around the stadium.**
- The road between the stadium and middle school will be closed to traffic so that it may be used for families exiting the stadium back to their cars.
- The entrance to the processional begins at the **top** of the stadium sidewalk leading down to the track. There will markings on the sidewalk to keep families 10' feet apart.



Once you enter the stadium, families will be staged 10' apart on the track and field. After the graduate receives his/her diploma, he/she will take a family picture. We are also live streaming the event for extended family and friends to watch.

Please review the updated field layout below:



As a reminder, we are following the CDC guidelines to ensure a safe diploma ceremony, so please wear a mask, practice social distancing, and if you do not feel well, please stay home.

In order for us to have a traditional commencement ceremony, the guidelines issued by the Commonwealth would need to permit large group gatherings up to 2500 people. If a change is made to the number allowed to gather, our commencement date will be July 30th with a rain date of July 31st (July 2nd is no longer an option).
