Student Drop-Off Reminders

Please follow the car-rider drop off procedures described below. This procedure helps us maintain our students' safety during morning arrival.

Stay in a single line next to the curb. *Do not pull around vehicles that are waiting at the curb.* Pull forward to the second cafeteria door (Door #6). Remain in your vehicle as your student exits. Pull away as soon as he or she is safely on the sidewalk. Continue to follow the curb back to the fence, turning left and exiting out of the lot onto Haberlein Rd.

As a reminder, all students should attend school daily unless they have the following symptoms:

- A fever of 100 degrees or more
- Vomiting or diarrhea within the last 24 hours
- A suspicious rash
- A fever that is accompanied by a stomach ache or fatigue
- A recurring headache lasting 1-2 days
- Red, irritated eyes with pus-like or excessive watery drainage
- Persistent, uncontrollable coughing
