Medication Administration on Trips

Medication administration is discouraged during field trips and school-sponsored trips, except for medication required for serious health conditions. However, if it is necessary for medication to be taken, the following procedures shall apply:

1. The parent/guardian shall be responsible for providing any medication to be taken on the field trip or school-sponsored trip. The medication must be sent to school on the morning of the trip in the original pharmacy labeled container or original package and accompanied by specific directions and authorization from the parent/guardian. Authorization forms may be obtained from the school health office or downloaded from the district's web site.
2. All medications shall be entrusted to a district staff member. Students may carry inhalers or emergency medications if a permission form is on file in accordance with this policy.
3. The student must self-administer the medication under the supervision of a district staff member.
