



Goal #1 – Strengthen curricular and instructional practices to support innovative teaching and learning, with a focus on building collaboration, communication, critical thinking, and creative problem-solving skills.

- Promote continuous growth in our students and faculty by encouraging innovation, collaboration, and instructional excellence.
- Increase our teachers' capacity to provide opportunities for students to engage in deeper learning experiences such as rigorous project-based learning, inquiry-based learning, student-centered design, and interdisciplinary thematic understandings.
- Use technology as a tool to empower deeper learning through academic rigor, creative communications, innovative design processes, and a global perspective.
- Vertically align K-12 science to advance research-based best practices in curriculum and instruction.
- Use data to guide instructional planning so that students grow and achieve foundational skills in key content areas.

Goal #2 – Promote overall wellness, well-being, and safety of our students and staff.

- Continue to promote a culture of Dignity and Respect for all by investigating *Social and Emotional Learning* frameworks which would empower students to build their self-management strategies, enhance interpersonal skills, and make responsible decisions.
- Utilize the School Wellness Committee to promote health and wellness for students and staff.
- Refine and provide opportunities for all students to explore and examine their paths toward colleges and careers.
- Continue to engage experts and research-based best practices in ongoing measures to analyze and enhance District-wide safety and security.

Goal #3 – Create mutually-beneficial opportunities that promote engagement and collaboration with the entire school community.

- Develop opportunities for appropriate regional professionals to mentor our students in authentic, real-world problems.
- Empower the School Start Time Committee to engage the school community in examining the possibility of implementing a later school start time.
- Create and launch a Business Advisory Committee to engage in conversations around local economic trends, connections between education and employment, and funding opportunities.
- Continue to expand the Lifetime Learning Academy and promote to all area residents.

Goal #4 – Ensure that District facilities continue to serve as modern, well-designed, high-quality spaces for teaching and learning.

- Expand opportunities for community input to help determine the overall scope, efficient design, and sequencing of the High School project.
- Pursue non-traditional funding sources for capital improvements and other District assets.
- Finalize a multi-year financing plan that is designed to support the funding required for a High School Project.
- Determine and implement safe and appropriate access to outdoor athletic facilities on the secondary campus.
- Analyze assessment data and ensure appropriate funding to continue supporting physical and cyber upgrades to safety and security.
- Explore additional facility user fees and student activity fees to support capital improvements.
